Incredibly Rare 2000 Vintage Single Vineyards ANGELO GAJA, PIEDMONT

Good afternoon,

To this day a bottle of 1978 Costa Russi by Angelo Gaja is one of the greatest wines I have ever had the pleasure to drink. Unlike myself, it defied its age, showing all the hallmarks of a much younger wine. I can think of few other wine makers who have the ability to create wines that age so well. Antonio Galloni comments *"although Gaja's wines are often flashy upon release, these bottles attest rather eloquently to the glacial aging that is the hallmark of the house style."*

Described as *"the man who dragged Piedmont into the modern world"*, Angelo produced his first single vineyard Barbaresco in 1967, which was the Sori San Lorenzo, followed by the Sori Tildin in 1970 and finally the Costa Russi in 1978.

In 1996 he declassified his DOCG Barbaresco status as he wanted to add 5% Barbera into the Nebiolo, which is why the word Barbaresco does not appear on the Single Vineyard labels. Now considered to be some of the finest wines in the world **this is a unique opportunity** to discover why Robert Parker thinks Angelo Gaja is *"a genius."*

Due to the fact they are highly prized by collectors, you do not often see older vintages on the market, however, we have been able to purchase a parcel from Angelo's oldest friend in the UK. He bought the wines en primeur and has kept them stored in perfect Bond conditions ever since. These wines are drinking beautifully now but will age effortlessly for another few decades. If you have never tried one of Angelo Gaja's single vineyards with age before, I highly recommend buying a case or two or perhaps all three – the wine is in stock now and is offered to our customers at the best price in the world today (it is worth noting that Gaja's 2013 Single Vineyards were released last year at £1695 per case in bond which only highlights what an incredible buy these 17 year old cases are at our prices!):

Despite its sheer power, the 2000 isn't as explosive as it can be. Still, there is little doubt the 2000 Sori San Lorenzo has the stuffing to age well for many years to come. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2030." 96 Points, Antonio Galloni
